

Thread Trail Quilt Week 4

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Block 4 - Cake Stand

Cutting Instructions:

All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance.

From the background print Fabric Cut:

- one of 2½" x 2½" squares (A).
- four of 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares (B).
- two of 2½" x 8½" strips (C).
- one of 4⅞" x 4⅞" squares, cut in half on the diagonal once. You will only need one of these half square triangles for this block (D).
- one of 8⅞" x 8⅞" squares (E).

From the brown print Fabric Cut:

- one of 8⅞" x 8⅞" squares (F).
- one of 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares, cut in half on the diagonal once to yield two half square triangles (G).

From the blue print Fabric Cut:

- four of 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares (H).

Piecing Instructions:

1. Gather one fabric piece labelled (B) and one labelled (H). Using these squares and following the instructions found in the General Instructions for piecing half square triangle units, piece two half square triangle units.
2. Repeat for a total of eight half square triangle units.
3. Gather one fabric piece labelled (E) and one labelled (F). Using these squares and following the instructions found in the General Instructions for piecing half square triangle units, piece two half square triangle units. You will only need one of these units for this block.
4. Gather the remaining fabric pieces.
5. Referring to the block photo for placement, layout these pieces and the half square triangle units to build your block.
6. Piece the block together, firstly into rows, and then the rows around the centre large half square triangle unit, finishing off with the (D) triangle in one corner.

Your completed block should now measure 12½" x 12½" square.
