

# Thread Trail Quilt Week 7

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## Block 7 - King's Chain

### **Cutting Instructions:**

All instructions include a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

From the dark brown print Fabric Cut:

- five of  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (A).

From the brown /red print Fabric Cut:

- four of  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares (B).

From the green print Fabric Cut:

- four of  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares (C).
- two of  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (D).

From the cream/green print Fabric Cut:

- six of  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (E).

From the cream print Fabric Cut:

- four of  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (F).



### **Piecing Instructions:**

1. Gather one fabric piece labelled (B) and one labelled (C). Using these squares and following the instructions found in the General Instructions for piecing half square triangle units, piece two half square triangle units.
2. Repeat for a total of eight half square triangle units.
3. Gather the remaining fabric pieces.
4. Referring to the block photo for placement, layout these pieces and the previously pieced units to build your block.
5. Piece the block together, firstly into rows, and then the rows into the block.

*Your completed block should now measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.*
