

# Thread Trail Quilt Week 8

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## Block 8 - Memory Block

### Cutting Instructions:

All instructions include a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

From the cream background print Fabric Cut:

- one of  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces (A).
- two of  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (B).
- eight of  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half on the diagonal once to yield eighteen half square triangles (C).
- two of  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares (D).
- one of  $3\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{5}{8}$ " squares, cut in half on the diagonal twice to yield four quarter square triangles (E).

From the light blue print Fabric Cut:

- two of  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half on the diagonal once to yield four half square triangles (F).
- one of  $3\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{5}{8}$ " squares, cut in half on the diagonal twice to yield four quarter square triangles (G).

From the red print Fabric Cut:

- two of  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half on the diagonal once to yield four half square triangles (H).
- two of  $3\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{5}{8}$ " squares, cut in half on the diagonal twice to yield eight quarter square triangles (I).

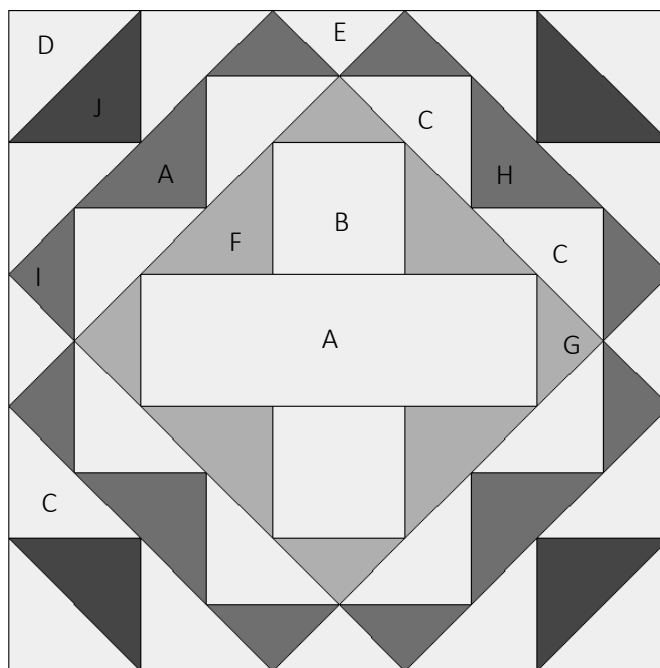
From the dark blue print Fabric Cut:

- two of  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares (J).



## **Piecing Instructions:**

1. Gather one fabric piece labelled (D) and one labelled (J). Using these squares and following the instructions found in the General Instructions for piecing half square triangle units, piece two half square triangle units.
2. Repeat for a total of four half square triangle units.
3. Gather the remaining fabric pieces.
4. Referring to the block diagram below for placement, layout these pieces and the previously pieced units to build your block.



5. Piece the block together, firstly the centre, and then the rows out from the centre. Finally the corner triangles.

*Your completed block should now measure 12½" x 12½" square.*
