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Block 10 - Pine Tree

Cutting Instructions:

All instructions include a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

From the cream background print Fabric Cut:

- seven of $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces (A).
- two of $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " pieces (B).
- one of 5" x 5" pieces (C).

From the green print Fabric Cut:

- one of 8" x 8" piece (D).

From the brown print Fabric Cut:

- one of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" piece (E).

From assorted leaf Fabrics Cut:

- a total of seven of $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces (F).



Piecing Instructions:

1. Gather one fabric piece labelled (A) and one labelled (F). Using these squares and following the instructions found in the General Instructions for piecing half square triangle units, piece two half square triangle units.
2. Repeat for a total of fourteen half square triangle units.
3. Gather the fabric pieces labelled (C), (D) and (E). Cut the (C) and (D) piece on the diagonal once to yield four half square triangles.
4. Piece the (E) strip between the two (C) triangles along the long edge of the triangles and strip. Note that the bottom of the strip will need to be cut to form the right angle corner of the larger pieced half square triangle.
5. Piece this triangle to one of the (D) half square triangles, along the long edge. This unit is the corner square that is the tree trunk in the photo
6. Layout the remaining triangle units and (B) squares as in block photo.
7. Piece together, firstly into side and top units, then all units into the block.

Your completed block should now measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
